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 Our experience in the past is that the most cost effective way to travel to/from the ferry port is by use of shared taxis. We recommend that travellers near to one-another arrange taxis mutually and share costs. By this means and with the almost universal availability of mobile phones transfers to and from our area and the ferry port can be arranged for both the <i>Outward and Inward</i> journeys. Some members may still prefer the option of placing their car in the long-term car park for the duration of the trip. Travellers will need to have a valid <i>Passport</i> and bring it with them.
