King John, the last English King to grant a general charter of liberties, the charter of liberties granted to his barons, and with King Henry's permission, in 1178, gave the lands which became the Abbey, to the Benedictine monk, Henry of Blois. Henry of Blois was a man of letters, and was a great scholar and a great teacher. He was the first of the Montagu family to be educated at the University. They kept the abbey until the 16th century when it was dissolved.
